MINUTES

Present were Mayor Pro Tem Jerri Chism, Aldermen Rudy Dudley, Lynn Cox, Jeremy Livingston and City Secretary Tina Love. Absent was Mayor Randy Hodges and Alderman Mona Brown.

1. CALL TO ORDER by Mayor Pro Tem Jerry Chism at 5:30 PM

2. PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS:

2-1: Consider a zoning change for Hopes Home of Texas located at 210 East Williamsburg, Lone Star, Texas and an adjoining lot. Also, consider an ordinance variance for the minimum footage requirement on a single-family dwelling, and consider the placement of two or three tiny homes, on the adjoining lot to Hopes Home of Texas.

Ms. Bobbie Delese, of Hopes Home of Texas, is asking for the facility (previously a church) located at 210 East Williamsburg, Lone Star, Tx., located in a single-family zoning district, be re-zoned to Commercial "B"; therefore, in compliance with City zoning ordinances. She is also asking for a variance to consider placing two or three tiny homes, on parcel number 10544 adjoining Hopes Homes, which do not meet the minimum 750 square feet structural requirements in accordance with the City ordinance.

A phone in meeting participant, Keith Reiter, feels that Hopes Homes is offering a good service; however, is concerned the expansion of the business could affect the safety of the neighborhood. He also expressed concerns of adding tiny homes to the neighborhood could decrease the property values of homes in the surrounding area.

It was suggested that Ms. Delese get a petition signed by surrounding neighbors to ensure there were no issues with the addition of tiny homes to the facility. Lynette Andrews, another phone in participant, offered to help Ms. Delese get a partition together and passed around the neighborhood. This partition will need to be available for review at the next scheduled council meeting.

A motion was made to rezone the property as commercial "B" and to table the addition of tiny homes until the next meeting; however, this being a Public Hearing, does not allow actions to be taken. Instead, these items will be discussed and voted on at the next scheduled council meeting.
