## 6. NON-ACTION ITEMS

6-1: An update on the USDA water/wastewater system improvement project and boat ramp projects will be provided.

City Secretary, Devon Whatley, made a report regarding the status of the easements with US Steel. US Steel required liability/indemnification language in the easements. This addition was made and we are currently awaiting the signing of the Easements by US Steel.

Mayor, Karl Stoermer, reported that he believes we will be able to accept bids soon on the boat ramp project.

## 7. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

7-1: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action by the Council concerning amending Ordinance 205-C Regulating the Keeping of Animals and Fowl Within the City of Lone Star to allow chickens. Draft language of a proposed amendment will be considered.

A motion was made by Randy Hodges and second by Lynn Cox to approve the proposed language of the amendment, with the addition of excluding multi-family/commercial property, restricting chickens to single family residential properties, requiring chicken pens to be a minimum of fifty feet from the property line and allow at least twelve square feet per chicken. There will also be a \$25.00 per year fee. All present voted aye.

7-2: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action by the Council to consider changing the garbage collection day from Tuesday to Thursday, at the request of Sanitation Solutions.

A motion was made by Randy Hodges and second by Jerri Chism to move the garbage collection date from Tuesdays to Thursdays. The last Tuesday garbage collection will be Tuesday, June 6, 2017 and the first Thursday garbage collection will be June 8, 2017. All present voted aye. Josh Bray with Sanitation Solutions agreed to pay to advertise this change. (Agenda items were heard out of order and Alderman Ryan Harte was not present for this vote.)

7-3: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action regarding use of the Lone Star Elementary building. Jerry W. Johnson with Lone Star Technical College will speak to the Council regarding reopening the school to bring back a sense of pride, jobs and economic development to the community.
