A motion to approve Reports 5-1 through 5-7(a) and (b) was made by Mona Brown, with a second by Jerri Chism. All present voted aye.

6. NON-ACTION ITEMS

6-1: Economic Development Board Chairman Mitch Cox will update the City Council regarding improvements to the City Park and development of a proposed park in the Edgemont Subdivision, as well as a laundromat coming to Lone Star.

Economic Development Board Chairman Mitch Cox reported to the Council that the drainage is being completed in the City Park. Mr. Cox stated he would like to fill the hole at the end of the boat ramp (caused by the acceleration of props when trailering boats while lake levels are low) with concrete slabs. The EDC is looking at purchasing additional playground equipment for younger children at a cost of approximately \$13,000.00. This item, as well as quotes to remove additional trees from the City Park will be brought before the Council for approval at a later date. The EDC is also researching the installation of a 30'x60' pavilion with lights and tables in the City Park. Heartland has quoted \$134,000.00 to install playground equipment, fence, basketball court and picnic tables in the proposed Edgemont Park.

Mr. Cox reported that Robert Hunt has approached the EDC regarding a loan from the EDC to open a laundromat in Lone Star. That request has not been pursued farther, as Mr. Hunt has advised that he will fund the building with his own money and finance the equipment through the equipment company.

6-2: The City will host a Trunk-or-Treat in the Crump's Shopping Center on Thursday, October 31 from 5:00 to 7:00 pm

6-3: Fall Clean-Up will take place October 21 through October 27. Dumpsters will be available in the lot just east of City Hall, between Hwy 259 and Jefferson Street.

7. ACTION ITEMS

7-1: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action by the Council to consider approving additional funds for the purchase of a patrol car. The City has received a grant from the Office of the Governor for the purchase of a patrol car in the amount of \$24,300.00. The Council approved \$4,000.00 for equipment on the vehicle. Sgt. Stephen Rathbun received a quote from Dana Safety Supply, Inc. for a 2019 Dodge Charger, fully equipped for a total of \$33,694.00. This amount exceeds the approved amount by \$5,394.00.

A motion to approve the quote from Dana Safety Supply, Inc. for the equipped 2019 Dodge Charger in the amount of \$33,694.00 was made by Mona Brown, with a second by Trent Duke. All present voted aye.

7-2: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action by the Council to consider becoming a member of The Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (Buy Board) by executing the Interlocal Participation Agreement. This membership gives the City access to hundreds of vendors for many items, including larger items like fire trucks. Provisions exist which allows governmental entities to purchase large items (over \$50,000.00) without going through the bidding process, as vendors have already been vetted by the Coop for best value.

A motion to approve executing the Interlocal Participation Agreement with The Local Government Purchasing Cooperative was made by Trent Duke, with a second by Lynn Cox. All present voted aye.

7-3: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action by the Council to approve City of Lone Star Tax Roll Approval and Tax Levy Resolution for Tax Year 2019.

A motion to approve the City of Lone Star Tax Roll Approval and Tax Levy Resolution for Tax Year 2019 was made by Mona Brown, with a second by Jerri Chism. All present voted aye.

7-4: Review, Discussion, and Possible Action by the Council to approve the proposed holiday schedule for 2020.
