2. ACTION ITEMS:

Review and discussion of the 2017-2018 Budgets and proposed property tax rate for 2017.

The "approval" of the Council in this meeting was for these items to be included in the proposed 2017-2018 budgets. The approval of the budgets will take place following public hearing.

The Council approved General Fund capital purchases of \$5,000.00 for bullet-proof vests for the police department and up to \$10,000.00 for a flat-bed truck to patch streets for Public Works. Capital purchases approved for the Water and Sewer Fund were \$50,000.00 for a used/low hour backhoe and \$8,500.00 to purchase a SCAG Cheetah to replace the ExMark at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. The Council also allowed for the sale of the ExMark mower.

The Council agreed to leave the property tax rate for 2017 at \$.523583 per \$100 valuation.

No action was taken.
