2. ACTION ITEMS:

2-1: Review, Discussion and Possible Action to adopt the proposed City of Lone Star General Fund and Water and Sewer Fund Budgets for Fiscal Year 2018 – 2019.

Budget line items 6870 IT Management (W&S) and 61018 IT Management (GF) each in the amount of \$9,000.00 were added and General Fund item 61013 Professional Services was reduced by \$9,000.00.

A motion was made by Mona Brown and second by Jerri Chism to adopt the City of Lone Star General fund and Water and Sewer Fund Budgets for Fiscal Year 2018-2019, with the above amendments.
