When the LSEDC approached Mr. Stacy Attaway and explained the VIP program, he was thrilled that this program was being offered. After meeting with members of the LSEDC, Mr. Attaway determined that the first thing he needed assistance with was a new sign for the front of his business. The old sign had been damaged by strong winds from a spring storm. The sign was damaged to the point it was irreparable.

Once Mr. Attaway met with the EDC, defined what was needed and filled out the application and other required documents the project was approved by the LSEDC. Mr. Attaway obtained bids for the sign's replacement. We are proud to announce the sign was replaced with a new sign. The new sign was installed on November 11, 2021.
